700 Events: – YES 700 Events... this is not a typo!

28 Patches: - 1 Camporee patch, then & 2 Weekend Subcamp Patches (Trade the spare) or 1 Day Pass Patch
12 Program Award patches: plus a Staff Patch makes 13; **Do the Events and Earn the Patches!**
Demolition Drag Derby, Teamwork, Subcamp Relay Race, Craft Events, Outdoor & Nature Skills, Fun Events, Educational Events, Perfect Inspection, Scouting Excellence, Sport Events, Shooting Ranges, Event Volunteer.

Plaques: ~ 200 plaques are awarded for Scouting Excellence, Youth leadership recognition plaques, Etc.

Fee/person:

Day Pass (Cubs / Troops): **\$12** Early Bird Special (Pay by Monday Oct 2nd, 2016) **OR** **\$15** at the Camporee

This is a Family Event - Cubs, Scouts, parents, siblings, friends all pay the Day Pass Fee and will receive a Camporee Patch, a Day Pass Patch and the Pizza Lunch in the Dining Hall. Parents may give their patched to the youth to trade. DAY PASS may earn as many of the 7 Program Patches as possible. See the Event Card at the Camp when you register.

Weekend Campers: There are 3 different payment plans. **Troops may do 1 &/or all 3 types of payment.**

- 1) **4th of July Special** – Weekend Troops / Crews / Staff @ \$17 per person (see the July 4th form on-line)
- 2) **Early Bird Special** - Pay by Monday Oct 2nd 2017 @ \$20 per person
- 3) **Pay at the Camporee** @ \$25 per person - See the Weekend Form 1b

Adults, Crews on Staff or Weekend: Fees are the same as Weekend above. Crews may attend with the Troops, or Crews / Adults may sign on as Staff and overnight in the Staff Subcamp. We also offer a Staff Meal Plan for purchase. We will also have a **STAFF DAY PASS** - see page 2.

Everyone is invited! We have Canadian & BSA Troops from several different Councils attending the CTC.

We have 28 patches & offer 700 Events. Attendees may earn Program Patches in the following categories,

NOTE – There is only 600 of each to be earned! If, or when we run out extras may be purchased at the CTC Store.

Educational / Teamwork / Crafts / Fun / Sports / Outdoor and Nature Skills / Ranges

CUBS: - Of all ages. Bring your entire family with you on a Day Pass!

Program events are available for **cubs of all ages**. Parents and siblings may attend as well and enjoy all the CTC has to offer. A Day Pass allows the youth to participate in the 670 events providing the individual event is "age appropriate".

Day Pass Patches include the **CTC Patch** and an **Oval or Round Day Pass Patch** with a button loop.

Cubs are eligible to earn Program Patches as per the Event Card requirements. The 7 Program patches are included in the Day Pass Fee and can be earned by Day Pass attendees are shown below. Each youth can get up to 9 total patches on a Day Pass.

Educational Events, Crafts, Outdoor & Nature Skills, Demolition Drag Derby, Teamwork, Fun Events and Sport's Events.

The Day Pass registration fee includes a Pizza lunch at the Dining Hall at noon.

Webelo & Arrow of Light (AOL):

AOL can attend with the entire Pack on a Day Pass as described above, **OR**

AOL may attend with a Troop that is attending the CTC Camporee for the entire Weekend. A parent may also attend with the AOL if they choose to. Patches will either be as described in the Day Pass above, or as per the Weekend Troops below.

This is a great way to introduce AOL to the Troop overnight Camping program. That is, for the weekend they will be part of a Troop. Past experience shows they will have a great time!!!! This also helps with youth retention.

TROOPS:

Troops (and Crews if they wish to) may attend for the Entire Weekend and participate in the 600 Events. Invite AOL / Webelos to attend with your Troop. The CTC provides a GREAT opportunity to recruit AOL / Webelos into your troop. Take advantage of the opportunity. We offer Award Plaques to the top 4 Troops that have the **most Overnight AOL / Webelos**.

Weekend Troops Patches include 1 large **CTC Patch** and **2 Subcamp Patches**. *Trade your extra Subcamp patch.*

Weekend Troops and Crews are eligible to **earn the 11 Program Patches as per the Event Card requirements**. The 10 Program patches that can be earned are included in the Weekend Fee. **Add the 3 from above and the youth could get 14 patches.**

REMINDER - There is only 600 of each to be earned! If, or when we run out, extras may be purchased at the CTC Store

Educational Events, Crafts, Outdoor & Nature Skills, Sport's, Teamwork, Shooting Ranges, Fun Events, Other Participation Patches - Subcamp Relay Race, Demolition Drag Derby, Perfect Inspection, Scouting Excellence, & Event Volunteer Patch.

Older Boys in a Troop that have outgrown the CTC Program are ready to become STAFF. The younger boys will then get an opportunity to be a Leader within your Troops when the older boys move on to become CTC staff. Should the older boys (Venturer age) not want to attend the CTC at all, bring the younger youth to the Camporee. Can't stay for the Weekend? Bring them on a Day Pass. ***They will have a blast! The CTC is a once in a year opportunity. Don't miss out on the fun!***

STAFF: from Troops / Crews / Adults – For Staff not with Troop's subcamps (Youth and Adults)

We are unprecedented with Youth Leadership at this youth run Camporee.

Adults / Crews: For Venturers that would like to attend the CTC as Staff, we offer a **Staff Subcamp Patch, 2 Staff Patches, a Staff Cap and the Large CTC Patch**. We also offer a meal plan that consists of **Friday Cracker barrel, Saturday Breakfast, lunch, Supper Saturday Cracker barrel and Sunday Breakfast**. The Staff Meal Plan may be purchased for - (Between \$17 and \$25 depending when you pay for it) **Crews and Teams** may stay in the Staff Subcamp. We have "Staff Subcamp Patches" for those who stay in this Subcamp.

PSAT SPECIAL – If you write the PSAT your STAFF fee **and** the Meal Plan is 50% off.

STAFF Day Pass – Register on a **STAFF Day Pass** by 9am on Saturday & help run events for the day.

The **Staff Day Pass Fee** includes a **Staff Cap, 1 Staff Patch & 1 large CTC patch & Lunch** in the Dining Hall.

We need **Adults & Senior Youth** to step forward on Saturday to be on Staff to help support the program of 600 Events.

Subcamp Staff: - There are several youth positions available in the Subcamps for attending Youth. These youth normally attend with their Troops and stay in the Subcamps with their units. They get their patches with the Troop.... but also get a Staff Patch and a Staff Cap. Subcamp positions are shown below....

Youth Camporee Chiefs, Sub-camp Chiefs, Event Area Coordinators, plus support youth on the Subcamp Staff Teams.

This opportunity is great for youth that may have outgrown the event participation part of the program. Don't let the older youth get bored of the Camporee. They **will outgrow** the events and that is the time to become a member of our Youth Staff Leadership Team. Adults help as advisors, running event or as part of the Service Team. **Staff souvenirs** include a **Camporee Staff Cap, a Camporee Patch, 2 Subcamp Patches and a Staff Patch**.
