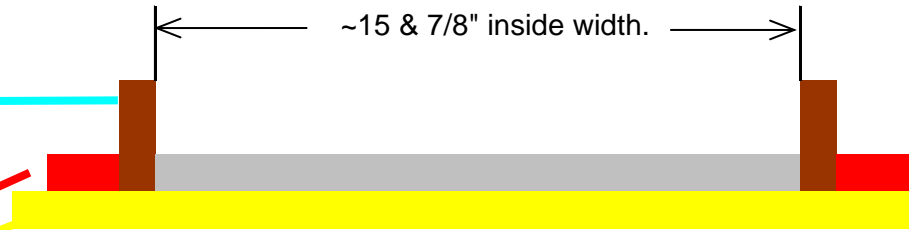
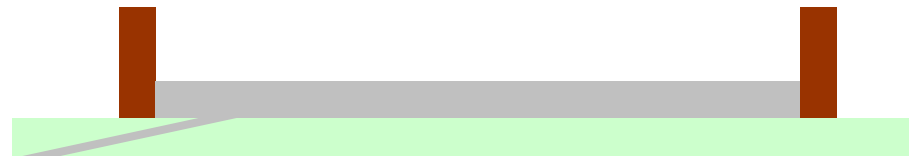


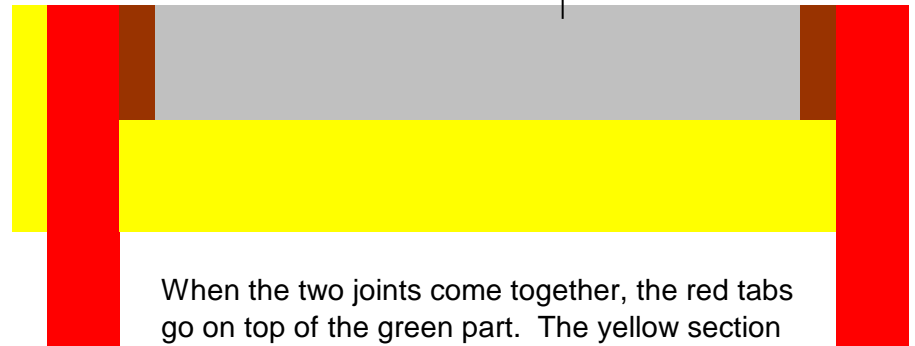
Top drawing is the Male part of the track. This end points down the hill. SIDE VIEW



Drawing below is the Female part of the track. This end points up the hill. SIDE VIEW



Track continues ↑



When the two joints come together, the red tabs go on top of the green part. The yellow section goes under the track part below. Red tabs centers track joints to ensure the sides do not stick out.

Track continues ↓

Brown: These parts are the sides.
 ~ 3" in height

The **Red** part protrudes ~4" beyond the track
 And slides over the Female Green part.

Yellow part protrudes ~ 2" out the front of the track to allow it to "slip" under the female part of the track.
