

Day Pass Schedule – 22nd Challenge Trophy Camporee

The CTC is GREAT for Youth retention in the Scouting Program

Bring the Entire family for a Day of fun! Fees include patches and Lunch.

Where? Camp Babcock Hovey, 7294 County Road 132, Ovid, NY. (Enter at the main entrance)

When? Saturday Oct 24/ 2020. Program runs from 9am to 4:15pm

The Day Pass is designed to be a family event... so bring the entire family! Everyone who pays the fees gets patches, pizza lunch and may participate in the ~ 750 Events where age appropriate. Yes Siblings may do events as well!

For Scouts of All Ages – Packs, Troops, etc.

STEP #1 – Please pre-register so we know approximately how many people are coming. We will accept walk-ins.

STEP #2 – Before the CTC – Print a copy of this Schedule with the CTC Map on the back for each adult.

STEP #3 - Make sure your medical forms are up to date. You keep your medical forms with you at the Camporee.

STEP #4 – Pay the \$13 per person Early Bird Fee by Oct 5th, 2020 or pay \$16 Oct 6th to the Camporee. *Your choice!*

NOTE 4.1 – Children 5 & under are free. Lunch is included but no patches.

NOTE 4.2 - FAMILY rate for 5 or more people is \$10 each - parents, their children & grandparents.


STEP #5 – Take all the PAYMENT info with you to ensure faster Registration. You can also register before the CTC.

STEP #6 – After you Register you will get Event Cards to do the Events.

NOTE 6.1 - Register @ SWC Office Wed Oct 21st & get your patches & Event Cards. Save time @ the CTC

Schedule: The info below describes the Day Pass Schedule – Saturday Oct 23th

8:45 to 9:00am **Arrival:** Enter the Camp at the B-H Main entrance and park at the Day Pass Parking Lot. Parking attendants in **Yellow / Lime safety vests** will provide direction. After parking, walk to Pedersen Lodge to register your unit. Send 1 person per Unit to register your unit. At that time you will receive Patches & Event Cards. Then you may walk to the Event Areas with your unit. (Refer to the CTC Map that should be copied on the back of this sheet).

Logistics: **Patches:** Day pass get the large CTC patch and a Day Pass patch at the Registration Desk. Day Pass people can earn the Program patches by doing the Events as listed on the Event Card.
Event Cards: Divide the youth in patrols. Get 1 set of Event Cards per Patrol of 5 to 9 youth.
PROGRAM Patches – Cubs may earn these BUT the quantity is limited to approximately 800 of each available to all scouting youth. *When we run out, buy the missing ones at the CTC Stores.*
CTC Stores – CTC Patches, etc: In Eagle Lodge (near Crafts) & in Tent near 1st Aid.
Bathroom Facilities? Port a Potties: Are located in the middle of the Sub-camp Field.
Latrines / Outhouses: Are located in several areas. Look for the small dark Brown wooden Outhouse / Buildings with Hand Washing Sinks outside. Look for the “**L**” on the CTC Map.
Drinking Water: The water at the latrines is potable. Look for the tap  on the CTC Map.

9:00 to 12 noon **Events:** Participate in the ~ 750 Events offered to the Scouting Youth.
NOTE: Youth can earn up to 7 Program Patches by doing Events as per the Event Card. *Program Patches are included in the Registration fees..... Pick them up at 1st Aid DON'T WAIT – These are limited to ~800 each Type of Patch & they will run out!!!* They are only awarded to the patrols that earn them the fastest. If they run out and you still want them they can be purchased at one of the CTC Stores shown on the map.

11:45 to 12:30pm **BLUE TICKET** - **Lunch:** Day Pass Pizza Lunch in the Dining Hall.

12:30 to 1:15pm **GREEN TICKET** - **Lunch:** Day Pass Pizza Lunch in the Dining Hall.
*Spare Time? Go visit Troops to see how they organize meals and their Campsites. This event is on your event card. No hurry! Afternoon **Event Areas** do not open until 1:15pm.*

1:15pm to 4:15pm Afternoon Event Areas – Continue participating in the ~ 750 Events.

4:15pm **The Day Pass Events / Program ends.** Keep your event Cards as souvenirs to show others. Day Pass units may go home, or if they wish, stay & watch the evening Troop level programs that includes, Sub-camp Relay Race (350 Racers in 60 minutes), Campfire, Scout's Own, etc. Those wishing to stay must provide their own supper, so please come prepared if you wish to watch the evening programs. Supper - You may eat the food you bring in the Dining Hall, or outside on tables at the Trading Tent
