EACH troop will be preassigned to a sub-camp. Get set up, fill out the registration form and pay fee at Pedersen Building. SPL / PL / Adult leader meeting is organized in YOUR subcamp staff area. The camp, rules, program, youth needed for campfire program and Relay Races, etc. will be discussed. Youth & Adult Volunteers must be "signed up" or assigned on Friday nite, or before Opening on Saturday.

 (350 racers in ~ 60 minutes!)
 ALL Racers get a CTC Racing Patch
 8:00 to 9:00 Camporee Scout's Own / Vespers
 or Catholic Mass - for all Denominations
 9:00 to 9:45'ish Camporee Campfire
 Earn an Event Volunteer Patch
 at the **Campfire or Scout's Own**
 9:45 to 11:00 Free time

Troops are responsible for their own time tables. I.e. don't be late!

If you arrive late, register as a "Weekend Unit" at Pedersen Lodge (Camporee Office) then give the subcamp staff the forms. Volunteers: PLEASE set up your program BEFORE it is time to run them. *Do not wait to the last minute.* Thank you for cooperating with this. See your Program sub camp staff. They are the coordinators. Please be at the opening. Even if you are not entirely cleaned up after breakfast. We can't wait too long for stragglers, so please be prepared. Youth and adults should be QUIET when asked to be. (Signs up) This the time of your 1st campsite inspection when you're at events.

Cook your own lunch. If you are volunteering to run PM Events, please be on time. All patrol should go to events. All Unit's adult volunteers to designated event area This the time of your 2nd campsite inspection if a "tie breaker" is needed.

Cook your own supper. If you wish, invite a STAFF member. Each patrol is responsible for bringing the EVENT CARD to the Subcamp Staff. Most event points for **5 patrols earn patches** if **on time & calculated** correctly.

BEFORE this race, each sub-camp should have their teams ready! See subcamp staff to join a race team. Assemble at the track and have fun. Refer to the "racing order" by subcamp color for each heat below to the right.

Scout's Own Vesper service is at the Stage following the Campfire The Catholic Mass is in the Dining Hall. Please be on time.

Camporee Campfire will be at the Amphitheater in front of the Stage immediately following the Chariot Race. The program must be worked out by the staff & youth volunteers. That is, skits, songs, cheers, etc

Youth have free time for trading badges and learning how to trade? Please be fair!
